Old Business:

1. Basil Ford 1540 Walden Av. David Przepiora investigated and reports that he sees no problem with this site plan.
2. 5050 Transit Rd. Apartment Complex and 14,800 SF commercial development. Richard Zynda investigated and reports 1. Pedestrian walkways/crosswalks need to be provided between the apartment buildings. 2. The entrance driveway needs to be reconfigured or relocated to avoid having apartment residents driving thru the parking lot. 3. Emergency vehicle access and turning radii need to be indicated.
3. Allied Dr. Motion was made to send a letter to the building inspector regarding the lack of sidewalk installation along Allied Dr. as we had requested in the last site plan approvals for Allied Dr.

New Business:

1. Revised site plan for Garden Village Plaza. Ted Skowron will investigate
2. Beach Rd. Received complaint from Donna Brzckcy regarding Fonda Dr and Beach Rd. intersection. She complains of no curbs and no sidewalks which happen to be the (school bus) stop. The bus has to turn onto Beach Rd. And stop in the middle of Beach Rd. Her son has to go around a ditch and into the street to catch the bus. The house on the corner of Beach Rd. and Fonda Dr. does not have a sidewalk in front of it and her kids have to ride their bike close to the street and over a sewer drain until they catch the sidewalk at the next house. It also makes for a dangerous bus stop for older kids who are standing next to the street in the dark waiting for the bus. She feels the corner needs to be put on the list for improvements. It is especially difficult turning right onto Beach Rd. from Fonda when there are snow banks in the winter. We recommend that the engineering department examine the

sidewalk situation and determine if sidewalks can be installed. The town board has the authority to order sidewalk installation at the property owner's expense. Regarding her other complaints it is noted that Beach Rd. is a County of Erie highway and any improvements are up the Erie County Highway department. This complaint should be addressed to them. Regarding the school bus situation the school bus routes are controlled by the school district and she should address any concerns about the school bus to the school district.
