Reading of the minutes of last meeting motion to waive by Ted Skowron and Seconded by Richard Zynda

Old Business:

1. Gateway apartments Genesee St. West of Transit. Robert Boye reports that this is an update design for the driveway to the Gateway Apartments Complex, in light of concern over its proximity to Calla Way, the access to Calla Pointe manufactured homes community next door. This new design calls for combining the gateway II driveway and Calla Way into one access for both complexes with a traffic signal at the combined driveway and Genesee St. If Bella Vista Group can come to an agreement with the operators of Calla Pointe to combine their respective driveways and NYSDOT grants a permit for a three color traffic signal @ Genesee St. and the driveway this is a favorable alternative to the original access design. Note that at this time there is no agreement in place to combine the driveways. Additionally such an agreement would need approval of the Town Attorney for legal reasons.
2. Left Turn signals Maryvale Dr. Cindy Strong was present regarding her request from the last meeting. She will be provided NYSDOT response regarding Union Rd. and Maryvale Dr. Due to change in representation from the police Dept. a study of Maryvale and Cayuga was not available. Lt. Berecz will look into this delay study.

New Business:

1. Tim Horton's 440 Pine Ridge Rd. Paul Gasiewicz investigated and reports that there will be adequate stacking in the drive thru lane. They have a 16 vehicle queue capacity. They also have pedestrian access from Pine ridge Rd. Approval is recommended.

2. Received P5 and P6 notices from DMV
3. Received EAC minutes
4. Received Planning Board minutes
5. Received reply from Building Inspector regarding Allied Dr. Sidewalks.
6. Received correspondence from NYSDOT regarding Maryvale Dr. & Union Rd. Transit & Genesee St. Both replies state that they will do a traffic engineering study and let the commission know the results.
