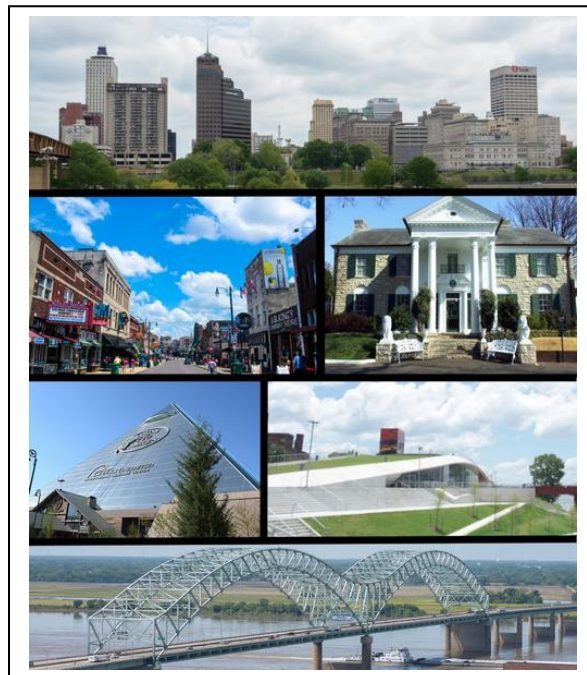

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ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Carrollton, Kentucky: Travel aboard a deluxe highway coach for the Carrollton, Kentucky area. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. This evening we gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 2: Memphis, Tennessee ~ The Guest House at Graceland ~ BB Kings Blues Club: Following breakfast we journey south into Tennessee and head west across the state to Memphis. This evening we gather for a group dinner at BB Kings Blues Club featuring great food and entertainment.

Day 3: Graceland Sights & Sounds: After breakfast spend the day exploring and enjoying Graceland. Your Elvis Experience Tour features Graceland Mansion Audio-Guided Tour with New Orientation Film, full access to state-of-the-art Visitor Entertainment Complex, Elvis Presley Car Museum, Elvis: The Entertainer Career Showcase Museum and Elvis' two custom airplanes. Explore the personal side of Elvis Presley with an interactive iPad tour of Graceland Mansion, hosted by John Stamos and featuring commentary and stories by Elvis and his daughter, Lisa Marie. Immerse yourself in Elvis' incredible career through hundreds of artifacts and photos from significant events in his life, as you tour the extensive Graceland Archives, including Elvis' amazing collection of gold and platinum records, his stunning jumpsuits, and other clothing, memorabilia from his movies, and more! Day 4: Memphis Sights ~ Peabody Hotel ~ Beale Street ~ Sun Studio: Following breakfast we journey into downtown Memphis and embark on a guided city tour. Many other musicians including Jerry Lee Lewis, B.B. King, Howlin' Wolf, Johnny Cash and Roy Orbison started their recording careers here at Sun Studio. Later today we gather for dinner at a local restaurant and then return to the resort for the night.

Day 5: Graceland ~ Covington, Kentucky: After breakfast we leave Graceland and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later today we arrive in Covington, Kentucky for dinner and final overnight.
