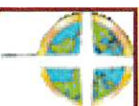

- 2** Proof of residency (utility bill, landlord statement, etc.)

3 And any of the following will be accepted for proof of income (all income must be disclosed):

- . DSS client ID cards
- . 1040 forms
- . Pay check stub
- . Medicaid or Food Stamp cards
- . Pension retirement cards or statements
- . WIC cards
- . Unemployment Insurance paperwork
